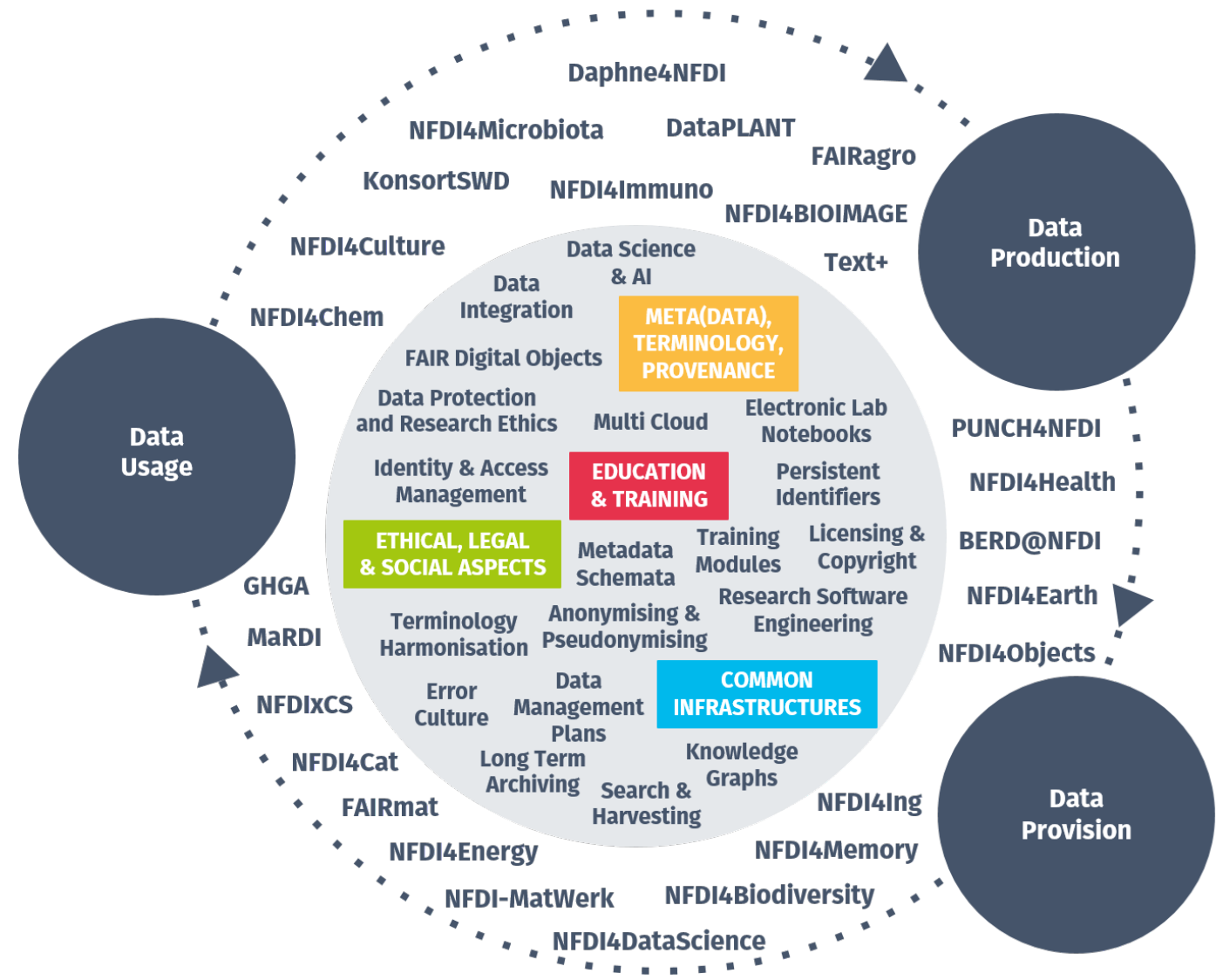

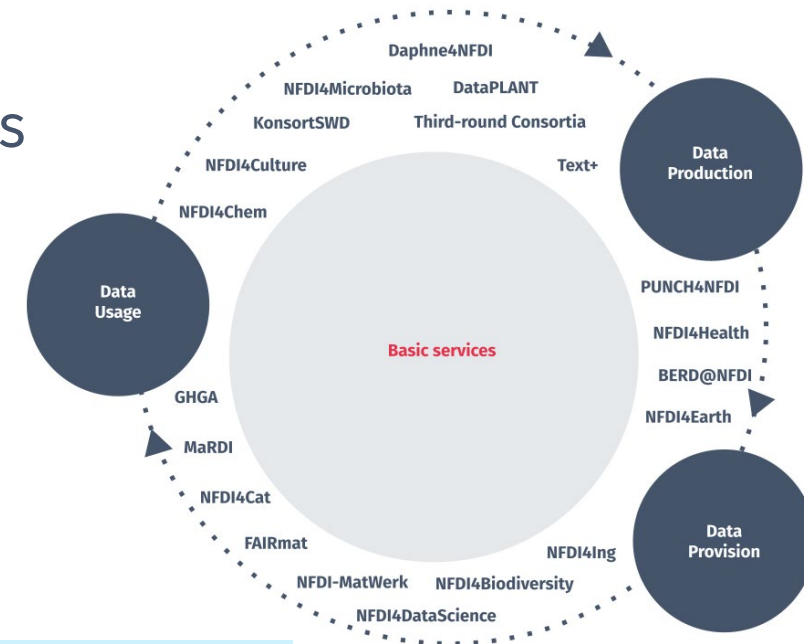

# Base4NFDI - Basic Services across NFDI consortia

- The 26 NFDI Consortia represent their specific domains and their infrastructural expertise including domain-specific basic-services
- Interoperability and cost-efficiency in NFDI however, requires NFDI-wide basic services



*A **service** is a technical-organisational solution, which typically includes storage and computing services, software, processes and workflows, as well as the necessary personnel support for different service desks.*

# What Base4NFDI will do

Translate needs & topics in basic services

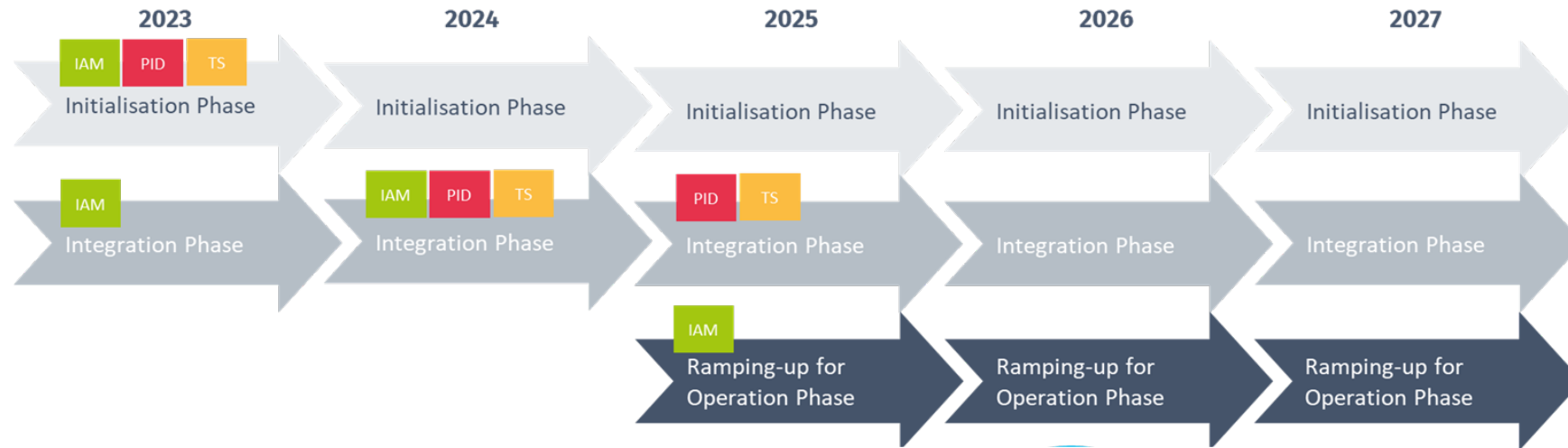


Base4NFDI provides the **NFDI-embedded framework** for

- user-driven requirements analysis and defining potential basic services **within NFDI Sections**
- **stepwise** development for integrating and ramping-up basic service candidates
- setting up **NFDI-wide basic service portfolio**
- monitoring and evaluation
- transparent allocation of flexible funding
- consensus building

# How Base4NFDI will deliver

(03/2023-03/2028 with a total of 24.5 Mio.€ Funding)

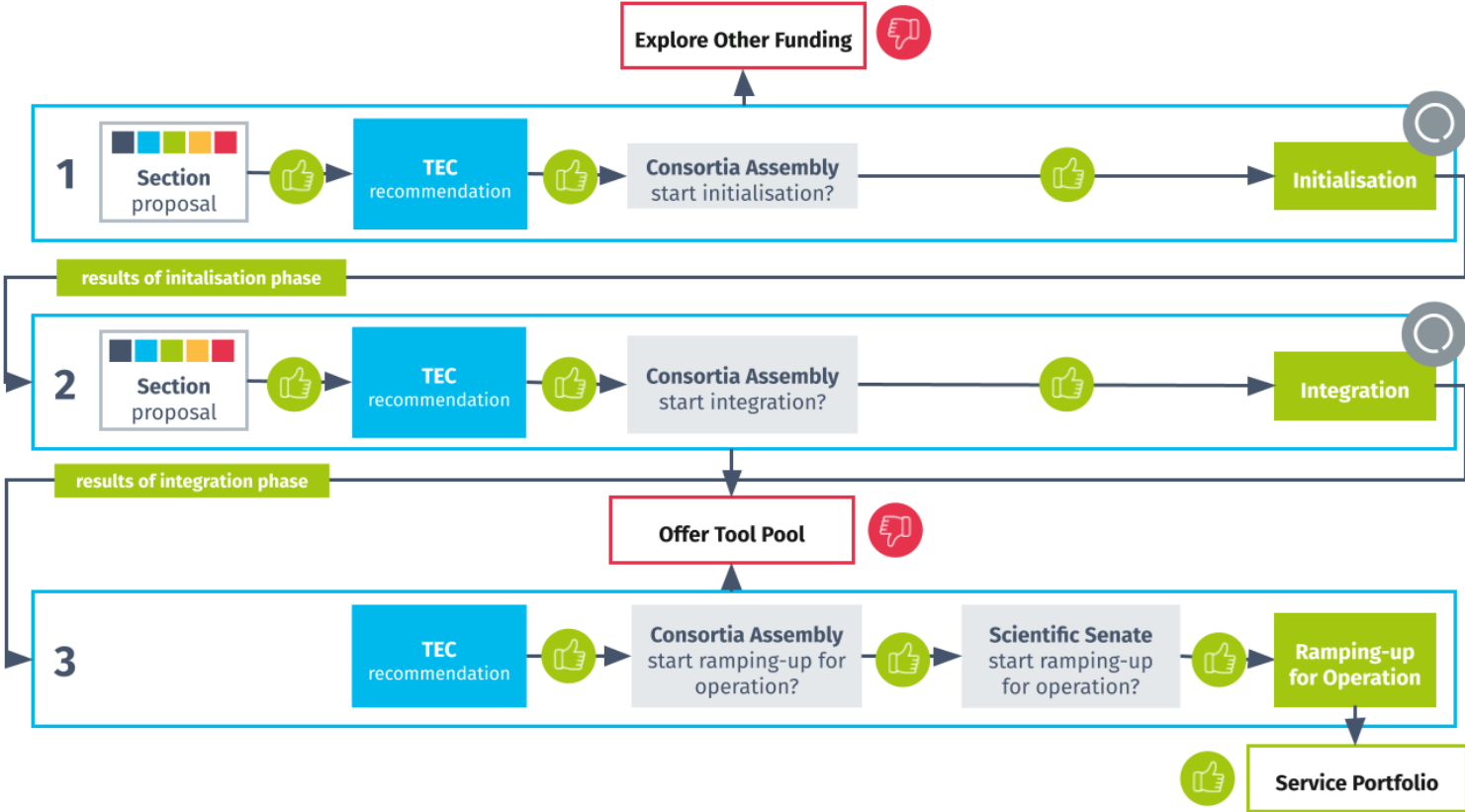


- **Flexible Funds** allow to adapt to organisational/technical dynamics and technical complexities
- Will enable development and roll-out of substantial number of services
- Will help to ensure integration in diverse existing landscapes by supporting adoption

# How Base4NFDI will decide

## Tightly embedded in the NFDI Association

- Each development step is subject to evaluation and joint agreement on next steps
- Proposals are initiated and coordinated by NFDI Sections
- Proposals are evaluated by **Technical Expert Committee (TEC)**, Consortia Assembly and Scientific Senate

# Base4NFDI

Who can apply, how, and for how much?

## WHO

- A lead institution and further participating institutions
- All institutions need to be (or have a route to become) members of a DFG-funded **consortium**

## HOW

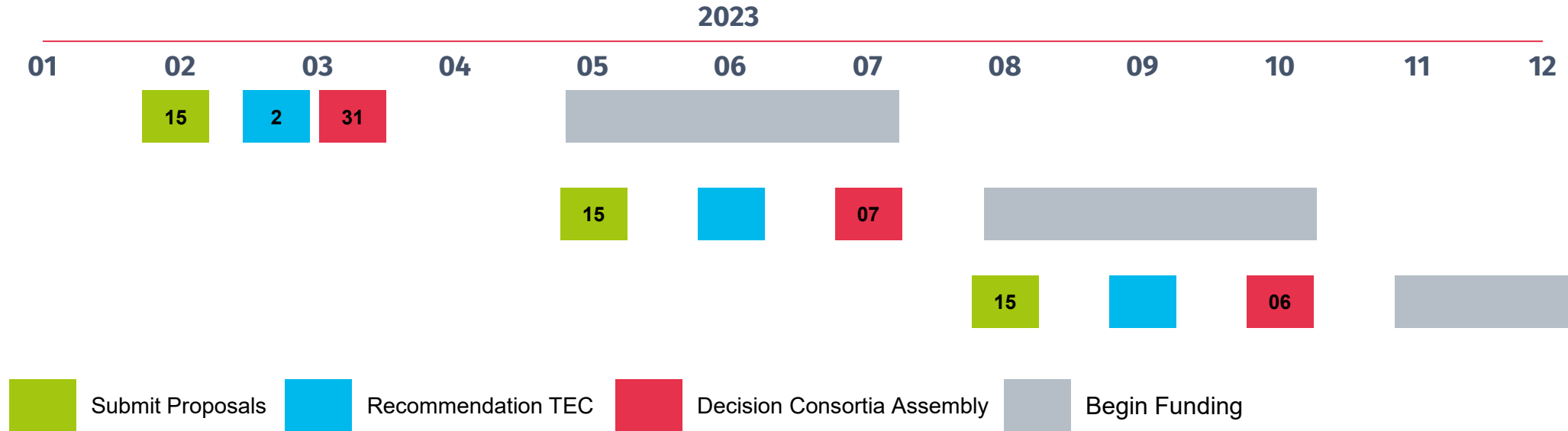
- A **template** for applications and an overview about criteria is available through <https://base4nfdi.de/>

## €

- Funds will be allocated based on “**building blocks**” per phase
- Using these building blocks proposals need to **specify** how many or which share of a building block they request

# Base4NFDI looking Forward

## Dates for 2023



- Three Base4NFDI Calls in 2023 and further calls in 2024/25 - **no need to rush!!**
- All potential services first submit **proposals** for the initialization phase
- The **Technical Expert Committee** will be completed in January 2023
- Binding decisions on funding to be made by the **consortia assembly**

# Proposals

from 1st Call **(1 proposal selected for funding)**

## 1. **IAM4NFDI - Basic Service “Identity and Access Management”**

IAM4NFDI will establish and provide a state-of-the-art AAI, that fosters cross-consortial and international collaboration. This NFDI Community AAI will be connected to the national identity federation DFN-AAI.

2. DMP4NFDI - NFDI Basic Service for Data Management Plans

3. Harvesting and Findability Enhancing Services – HaDES

4. Knowledge Graph Infrastructure - KGI

5. PID4NFDI - Persistent Identifier Services

6. Terminology Services 4NFDI - TS4NFDI

# Current Proposals

## from 2nd Call

### 1. PID4NFDI - Persistent Identifier Services

Will build an NFDI foundation service on established PID infrastructures. PID4NFDI will follow a clear path of promoting the uptake by PID infrastructures and service providers and will only develop and operate NFDI - specific services if necessary.

### 2. Terminology Services 4NFDI - TS4NFDI





Will provide a federated architecture of TS components and enable interoperability across disciplines to foster alignment of terminologies to build common knowledge representation and knowledge engineering framework across NFDI communities.

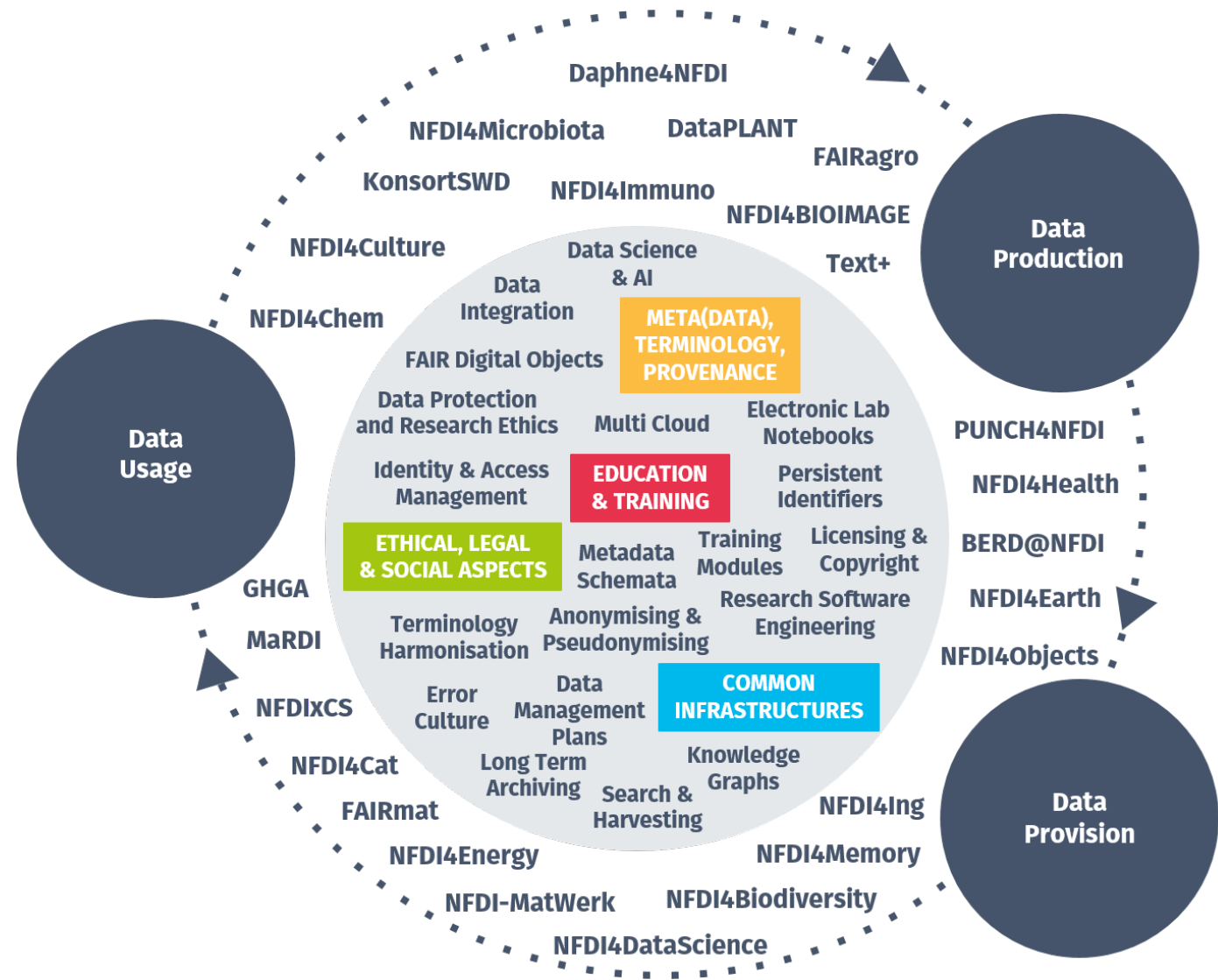
